



Tugu Negara: Where Sacrifice Meets Memory

Amid the celebrations and progress, there remains a place that grounds the spirit of *Merdeka* in solemn reverence: Tugu Negara, the Malaysian National Monument. Towering over the tranquil Lake Gardens in Kuala Lumpur, this magnificent bronze sculpture honors the brave souls who gave their lives for Malaysia's freedom. It's a place of remembrance, a site of national pride, and a living symbol of what it means to sacrifice for a greater good.

Commissioned in 1966 and designed by Felix de Weldon, the same artist behind the Iwo Jima Memorial in the United States, Tugu Negara is more than a war monument. It's an artistic embodiment of Malaysian values, courage, unity, leadership, vigilance, strength, suffering, and sacrifice represented by seven heroic soldiers immortalized in a moment of triumph and brotherhood. Every detail of the monument, from its towering scale to the expressions on each figure, invites visitors to pause, reflect, and remember.

Each year on Merdeka morning, Tugu Negara becomes the heart of the nation's memory. The Prime Minister, cabinet ministers, military leaders, and citizens gather for a wreath-laying ceremony that is as moving as it is majestic. The air is quiet, filled with reverence, as the Jalur Gemilang is raised once again. Beneath the marble base and the bronze figures, names are remembered, stories are honored, and a promise is silently renewed: their sacrifice will not be forgotten, and the freedom they secured will be preserved.

Merdeka 2025: A Celebration of Modern Progress

While the past is honored in monuments and memory, today's Merdeka lives in action. In 2025, Malaysia continues to rise, shaped by new challenges and empowered by new voices. One of the year's most notable achievements is the country's leadership in environmental initiatives. Through national campaigns and grassroots movements, Malaysia has planted over five million mangrove saplings, reinforcing its commitment to biodiversity, climate resilience, and ecological restoration. Sacred Heights and Ancient Roots

On the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur, limestone cliffs tower over the city's horizon. At their heart lies Batu Caves, its 272 colorful steps watched over by the golden statue of Lord Murugan, one of the tallest of its kind in the world. As prayers rise, so too do the memories of Malaysia's spiritual diversity and deep-rooted traditions. During Thaipusam, pilgrims walk barefoot here, echoing the resilience of generations.


Closer to the city center, Thean Hou Temple, a Chinese temple open to all. Its red lanterns welcoming pilgrims and tourists alike. It's one of the largest temples in KL and features architectural elements of Buddhism, Confucianism, and Taoism.

Further south in Putrajaya, Malaysia's administrative capital, modernity wears a gentle face. The Putra Mosque, with its pink dome mirrored in the calm Putrajaya Lake, is a favorite backdrop for national ceremonies. Across the water, the Seri Wawasan Bridge arches like a ribbon of light, representing forward motion, the path Malaysia continues to forge, strong and sure.



On National Day, Jonker Street becomes more than a market: it's a living museum, a tribute to generations of Peranakan families, Eurasian communities, and Malay settlers who together shaped the identity of Melaka. Flags hang from shophouses' windows, and the smell of satay and cendol wafts through the air.

This is where the world met Malaysia and where Malaysia learned to meet the world on her own terms.

Back on the peninsula, the rainforests of Taman Negara stretch across Pahang, Kelantan, and Terengganu, are some of the oldest in the world. Here, the sonas of hornbills, the rustle of leaves, and the rhythm of the river speak of a Malaysia untouched by time. Indigenous Orang Asli communities welcome visitors, showcasina traditions older than Merdeka itself, yet equally part of Malaysia's soul.

Islands of Wonder and Bridges of Tomorrow

Off the coast of Kedah, Langkawi sparkles under the National Day sun. Its legends, beaches, and geoparks attract travelers year-round, but today, the Langkawi Sky Bridge becomes a walkway to the heavens, as fireworks bloom in the sky above Gunung Mat Cincang. From this height, the Andaman Sea reflects the golden hour, while the people below rejoice in song and celebration.

Meanwhile, on the ground in Istana Negara, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong presides over official National Day ceremonies. Though not open to the public, its regal gates are crowded with well-wishers. The changing of the royal guards is met with cheers. It's a moment where monarchy and rakyat meet in shared pride.



A Nation United in Spirit

From the northern rice fields of Kedah to the palm oil plantations of Johor, from the longhouses of Sarawak to the business towers of Cyberjaya, the spirit of Malaysia burns bright.





Underpinned by a strategic focus to transform KL International Airport (KLIA) to provide more enhanced services to drive its growth and capacity, Malaysia Airports has implemented various improvements to deliver more tangible benefits to its passengers and stakeholders alike.

The refreshed transformation is part of the newly privatised airport operator's efforts to realise its long-term ambition to position KLIA as a world-class hub supported by strong connectivity, operational excellence and commitment to passenger-centric service.

Abd Hasman Abd Muhimim, General Manager of Operations at KLIA Terminal 1, told the media that since the first half of 2025 (1H2025), the terminal has undergone a RM30 million upgrade. He unveiled 14 initiatives during a walkabout to provide for a smarter, faster and friendlier experience at the flagship airport.


These improvements are timely with Malaysia chairing the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and travel intensifying ahead of Visit Malaysia 2026.

With KLIA's passenger traffic for the 1H2025 growing by 9.9% to 30.1 million compared to the same period last year, Abd Hasman said, "We aim to ensure the best possible service for travellers at every touchpoint."

A total of 36 family-friendly parking bays have been converted from 54 standard bays and sited at the basement and Level five of the short-term car park's blocks B and C. These bays are wider and located closer to the entrances, providing convenience for loading or unloading children, strollers and luggage.

Abd Hasman explained this move came due to the increasing trend of families travelling at KLIA. There is also a Help button where they can request for assistance.

For travellers' convenience, he said that 2,000 outdated baggage trolleys at Level 5 of the Departure Hall have been replaced with newly designed lightweight trolleys featuring strap-free handles and built-in brakes for easier manoeuvring and enhanced safety.



He added that 50 more robust wheelchairs, built according to the industry specifications for airport use, are now available free of charge at key locations throughout the terminal, with another 50 to be added later.

They are located near Door 4 of the Main Terminal Building (MTB) at Level 5 and at the airside area where the Aerotrain station is located at Gate H. In the Satellite Building, these flexible wheelchairs that designed to go up ramps are available at the Aerotrain station at Gate C.

Wayfinding at the Aerotrain stations has also been improved to help passengers navigate more easily at the MTB, Airside and Satellite Building.



To improve the overall passenger flow at the airport, he said seating areas at Level 5 have been relocated closer to the food and beverage outlets for added convenience and to ease congestion in the high traffic zones.

Abd Hasman said 80 washrooms have also been upgraded into fully integrated accessible facilities for the use of families and passengers with reduced mobility.



These washrooms have wider entrances with wheelchair-friendly layouts, accessible sinks with sensor taps, as well as grab bars and handrails. Additionally, emergency call buttons are reachable from the floor level.

Meanwhile, the nappy change room upgrade initiative will see five nappy change rooms refurbished with three unique themes, 'Fun/Playful, Luxury/Hotel, and Safari/Jungle' to create a more welcoming and family-friendly environment.



Each room is equipped with a feeding area, adult and child toilets, a baby cot, and a hot or warm water dispenser. So far, two of the nappy change rooms have been refurbished with the rest targeted for completion by August 2025.

Strengthening KLIA's reputation as a family-friendly international airport, two of the 'Fun/Playful' themed nappy change rooms will be located at the MTB, while one Luxury/Hotel theme room will be at the MTB Airside.

The Satellite Building, on the other hand, will feature two of the 'Safari/Jungle' themed nappy change rooms.

"We will continuously assess current needs and expand the facilities wherever necessary," Abd Hasman reiterated while showcasing some of the heritage walls or revamped public spaces to celebrate Malaysia's local culture, identity and heritage and turn them into insta-worthy moments for passengers at KLIA.
